All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors. Attended Funeral - Funeral Directors Charges Only

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the person who has died, at the same time as they attend their Burial or Cremation.

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£895.00
- Collecting and transporting the person who has died from their place of death into our care (normally within 20 miles of our premises)	£110.00
- Care before the funeral of the person who has died, at our premises, within appropriate and private facilities	£75.00
- Provision of an Oak Veneered Coffin (suitable for burial or cremation)	£395.00
- Viewing the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with our funeral director	£25.00
- At a mutually agreed date and time, we will convey the person who has died directly to the local cemetery or crematorium, of your choice, in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	from £195.00

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where Family and Friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the person who has died, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	from £995.00
Cremation (Funeral Directors Charges and Cremation fee) ²	£1495.00

Fees You Must Pay

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: £435.00

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the Cemetery/Churchyard may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended Cremation Funeral, the cremation fee.² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: £ 730.00 - £999.00
